Our sessions involve working alongside a horse or horses as a part of a team. Being with horses can help you to develop different ways of thinking, acting, and being around others. This can help you understand what you do, and why you do it and make the choices that are right for you.

Our sessions are not activity or task led, although tasks around animal care will be explored as a way to learn about yourself and others, as well as the animals themselves. You will also have the opportunity to complete some ASDAN Lifeskills Challenges.
